





Secretary Minutes for January 2014 RECORDED BY KRIS REYNOLDS

President Roger Woerner called the meeting to order at 7:10pm. There were 44 neighbors present. He introduced Mark Purvis, our Code Compliance representative, for those who didn't know him already.

The Homeowner's Association elections were motioned to start, after Patty Walker thanked the present board for their year of service. The chair of the nominating committee, Henrietta Bailey, gave the 2014 nominations for each office. There were no nominations from the floor, and no offices were contested, therefore a motion was made and seconded to accept and award the five nominations for Executive Board members as follows: Roger Woerner, President, David Adcock, Vice-President, Kris Reynolds, Secretary, Karen Thompson, Treasurer, and Derek Williams, Parliamentarian.

Joan Duff will be in charge of Programs for 2014, and she asked the membership for suggestions as to what speakers or types of programs they would like to hear this year. Madelyn Wattigney was announced as the new editor of the newsletter, after special mention was again given to Philip Smerick and the entire 2013 newsletter delivery crew (earlier recognized at the November Holiday Dinner).

Freddie Holcomb introduced herself as the Code Blue Coordinator for the East Side, and gave Feb 15 as the correct date of the next Code Blue training. The neighborhood needs more trained patrollers!

Pastor Milton Pace challenged the membership to invite/bring one neighbor with them for the February meeting. He had given wise 'Food For Thought' earlier in the evening when he rhetorically asked, "If we are not here to serve others, then what are we here for?" This was perfect segway for Kris Reynolds to pursue ideas for a Neighborhood Project for 2014. Whether a physical improvement, or service to our community, or welcoming and staying connected with our membership, or taking care of our own members in need, she stressed the need for our neighborhood to make a bigger mark in volunteerism and service.

Various ideas for speakers and programs were briefly discussed. David Adcock reiterated the need for greater membership and involvement, and will be offering a Door Prize to be awarded at each meeting in the future. Jean McClung spoke about the Stormwater Project meeting on Jan 28.

Roger concluded the meeting by mentioning a possibility of increased membership dues to \$25 next year because of increased printing costs. He also mentioned a possibility of changing from a Homeowner's Association to a Neighborhood Association. Both ideas are subject to additional discussion. Meeting was adjourned at 8:05pm.

The long awaited I-30 Gateway Monument preliminary design will be revealed on Wednesday, February 26, 2014, from 6-7 pm. The public is invited to attend. The artist team of Ety Horowitz and Kevin Sloan will make the presentation.

Both TxDOT and the Federal Highway Administration have done a preliminary safety review of the artists' concept. After the presentation your input and discussion will be welcomed.

According to reports at the last Captain's meeting the East division is the best side of town for safety. Thanks to all the Code Blue patrollers of Eastern Hills and all the other neighborhoods with Code Blue for the dedication to patrolling. There are only 13 reporting Code Blue groups in East Ft. Worth, way less than the other divisions. North, South, and West have 40-50 groups. Central has a few more than East.

While doing our patrols late at night, we see more porch lights on, motion lights coming on. This makes it easier to see down the sides of the house and the front door. It also says that Eastern Hills wants a safe neighborhood. Can you imagine seeing a 79" TV walking down the street? However, you cannot see jewelry or money going out the window. Jewelry can be identified with pictures.

Be a good neighbor, watch out for TVs and other large items walking down the street, slow moving cars or people on your street. Everyone doing their part in preventing crimes will keep the East Division the best. Just because a crime might happen at Eastchase does not mean that bad guy won't migrate west to our neighborhood. Your neighbor would not want a TV to disappear and neither would you. Protect each other.
