### WHY PARTICIPATE?

This event is a hassle-free, cost-free way to help reduce illegal dumping, minimize landfill waste, and prevent fire hazards. By responsibly recycling your tires, you are not just cleaning up your space but also helping keep Fort Worth beautiful and protecting our environment.

### WHAT CAN YOU BRING?

- Tires from all types of **passenger vehicles** are accepted, including cars, trucks, motorcycles, SUVs, and more.
- We prefer tires that are removed of oils, dirt, water and paint.
- Rims are accepted, but preferably separated from tires.
- Tires from commercial vehicles or 18-wheelers are **NOT ACCEPTED**.

### WHAT HAPPENS TO MY SCRAPPED TIRES?

Once collected, your tires will be taken to our recycling partner, where they will be transformed into useful products like playground surfaces, tire swings, asphalt, and landscaping materials. Some materials can even be repurposed to create tire-derived fuel.

## Vegetarian Lentil Soup

*Here's a hearty soup that's loaded with nourishing veggies and fragrant herbs. This vegetarian lentil soup is an easy, throw-it-together dish.*

### INGREDIENTS:

- 2 onions, chopped
- 6 garlic cloves, finely chopped
- 4 stalks celery, finely chopped
- 3 cups cubed potatoes
- 4 carrots, peeled, chopped into coins
- pinch of salt
- 1 cup dry green or brown lentils, rinsed
- 1 tsp thyme
- 1 tsp marjoram
- 1 bay leaf
- 12 cups vegetable stock
- 4 tbsp sour cream

### INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Heat 2 tablespoons of olive oil in a large pan (with a lid) over medium heat. Add onion, garlic and celery and saute until garlic is translucent and soft.
2. Add the cubed potatoes, carrots and season with a pinch of salt (the amount will depend on how salted your veggie broth is). Fry for about 1-2 minutes.
3. Add the lentils, thyme, marjoram and veggie broth. Cover the pan with a lid and bring the mix to a boil. Reduce heat and

let simmer for about 25-30 minutes or until lentils are soft but not mushy.

4. Take the soup from the heat and let the soup cool for 5 minutes.
5. Take out ¼ cup of the soup (without any veggies) and add it to a small bowl. Dissolve sour cream and add the mix back in to the soup.
6. For a creamier soup, blend about ¼ of it with an immersion blender (optional).
7. Taste and season with salt and black pepper. Serve garnished with fresh herbs.

### NOTES:

**Vegan:** Skip the sour cream.

**Rinse lentils before cooking:** Lentils are often dirty, so rinse until water is clear.

**Adjust consistency:** Make the soup thinner by adding more veggie broth or, for a creamier soup, blend some or all of the soup.

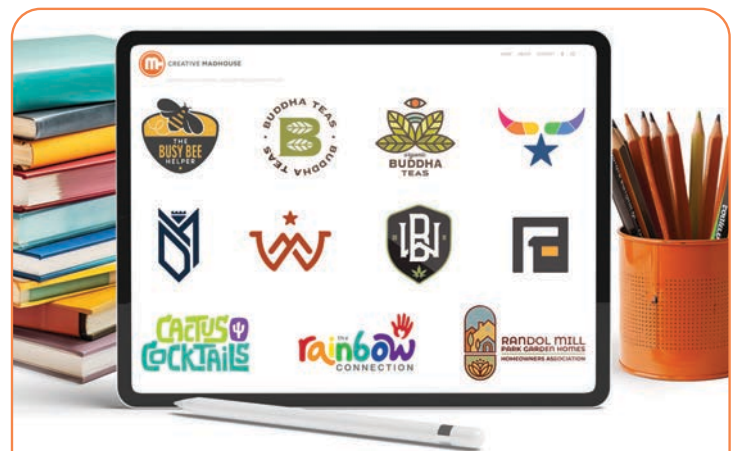
